## On Site Tutorials

We begin on site with an hour lecture covering plein air concepts, basic composition, mapping your vision, basic color theory, color mixing, and painting methods. We continue to paint for three hours with guidance completing the session with a plein air painting. *Voila!*

## Supply List

5" x 8", 8" x 10", or 9" x 12" canvas or panel  
brushes – flats, rounds, filberts, varying sizes  
medium – galkyd or traditional  
turpenoid (or odorless mineral spirits)  
rags or paper towels  
paint – warm and cool primaries, selection of earth tones, titanium white and bone black  
paint box or french easel  
palette  
small collapsible chair

\* **Materials provided for a \$15.00 fee.**

Includes the use of paint box, brushes, paint, and canvas or panel which is yours to keep.

\*\* Other supplies available for purchase include:  
small bottle of medium, canvas, panel, small starter size oil paints, selection of brushes, small can of odorless mineral spirits.
